

# Accepting Repeated Source Courses

## How do I accept source courses in TA the same way they were treated at the source institution?

The Repeatf setting in the student record is designed to identify a Source course as a repeated course, losing its GPA and its credit, and processing it the same way in the Target institution.

The encoding occurs in 3 places:

- Source Master Reference Table (IREF)
- Target Master Reference Table (IREF)
- Student record (Joe Cool)

In this example, the student has taken ENGL 1121 twice, with grades of F and C.

In normal processing, the Source F grade (universal grade symbol "0.0") would process into the Target grade table as non-transferable F (NTF).

On the audit ENGL 1021 is processed with the grade of NTF, but is not shown as a repeated course.

If you would prefer to identify the source courses as courses that were repeated, giving the F grade a >X, you will need to set up Repeatf. This application of REPEATF is set up to lose both credit and GPA of the first occurrence of the course.

**Step 1.** You need to have a single character condition code for testing in an articulation rule. On the Source grade table add the SPEEDE grade type, checked Institution to Universal grade of R:N, and a Universal Condition code of RPT. R:N, and RPT, are DARS defined.

**Step 2.** Define the condition code of RPT on the Target grade table as: N Calc, N Crdt and 0 Ct. The C1 and C2 (Cond1 & 2 Institutional codes) are arbitrarily defined in the COM table. Although C1 is hard to read, it is the minus sign (-), and C2 is the plus sign (+). The Universal Condition codes (UC1 and UC2) are both DARS defined. UC1 is \$GP, and UC2 is \$CR.

The articulation rule must be listed at the top of the Transfer Articulation table. The rule assigns all courses coming with the Source grade R:N Universal Grade RPT, with the condition codes of the minus sign (-) and the plus sign (+).

**Step 3.** In Joe Cool, within the student's academic record for the source institution (in this case: Anoka-Ramsey), highlight the course and open the Course Detail tab. In the SPEEDE box, encode the letter N (Repeated but not included in GPA). Save.

After rerunning the audit, the F course is identified with >X (carrot X), identified on this audit as, the course as “X No credit for repeat.”

**Supplemental encoding:** If you collect all repeated courses, you will need to complete one more step.

Within the TA rules, set up a rule which accepts any course with the condition code of (-), articulating it to a user chosen value for repeated courses. In this example, the repeated course is RPT T\*\*\*. This rule should be in your “processing” group of 0000001.
