

DARS Catalog

The DARS Catalog is normally defined on ISRS ST1100UG, the Area Study/Int tab.

A Student's defined catalog follows this hierarchy:

If catalog is forced in DA0001CP, this is the student's catalog.

DA0001CP

If a catalog in DA0001CP is not forced, the Dprog (catalog) defined in Joe Cool controls the student's catalog.

Joe Cool

If a catalog in DA0001CP, and Dprog in Joe Cool are not defined, the DARS Catalog YRTR field in ISRS ST1100UG, Area Study/Int defines the student's catalog.
