

MnTC Audit Guiding Principles in DARS The EMNTC

1. Each college and university shall pull MnSCU transcripts and electronic MNTC audits via eTranscript. Each college and university shall send the MNTC Audit with a transcript to the U of Minnesota institutions
2. Campuses must articulate all MnSCU courses for all students. Institutions can no longer select the minimum number of courses needed in a program.
3. MnTC courses carry only the Goal(s) from the sending institution. A direct equivalent course, with differing Goals from sending institution, may only carry the Goal(s) of the sending institution's course. Colleges and universities may have to reject some of Goal areas for equivalent courses. Documentation for rejecting Goal areas is at:

4. Exceptions on MNTC courses, Goal areas, and completion of the MnTC follow the student.
5. Residency for the MNTC can be defined by the certifying institution.
6. The completed MNTC is a minimum of 40 credits, in 10 goal areas, with a 2.0 GPA. College and Universities must bring in all successful MNTC courses and grades, and may define which 40 credits apply. Beyond the 40 minimum, institutions follow their own policies in determining how to include the remaining credits.
7. The MNTC Audit must include the GPA effect of all MNTC courses.

- Exceptions on MNTC courses
- Goal 2 requirement for Goal 2 courses

- TA tables for MnSCU institutions must include articulated courses for all MNTC courses from all MnSCU institutions.
- MNTC course changes for MnSCU schools must be updated in the MnSCU TA tables.

EMNTC Check list for technical colleges not certifying the MnTC

*Do you normally not accept D grades?

Assign course condition code, based on the MnTC goal identity (must have our tables with goal language in memo field). (Programmer can add the condition code to do this.)

Audit Appearance options for unique COM:

Show only successful courses in Goal requirements. Display Goal title text on Goal requirements. Do not display sub-requirement title text.

Display unsuccessful courses in “Courses not used” requirement.

Prevent INCLBOT from printing: Add COM BOTLNECT, insert 0000

Remove FULLDEMO2 from the MnTC COM

Prevent student name and address from printing with COM NMAIL insert 0000

Set TRLOOKMNT requirement completion rules to “X-suppress all” for Required Count, GPA, and Required Sub-req’s; set Required Hours to E-Suppress earned”. Set sub-requirement Required Count, Required Hours and Required GPA to “E-Suppress earned”; sub-requirement Reporting Options to: “T: Only report title”.
