

INCLTOP #RC# DISPLAYING ADVISOR ACCESS CODES IN INCLTOP

Advisor Access Codes, or Registration Access Codes as currently labeled on ISRS screen ST1108UG, can be displayed in INCLTOP using the entry #RC#. The Access Codes for terms greater than the current term, up to two, are printed (current term does not print).

Since the #RC# entry does display on the audit, it will be necessary to place it in the location in which it will print relative to other printable text. As can be seen above the entry is as follows:

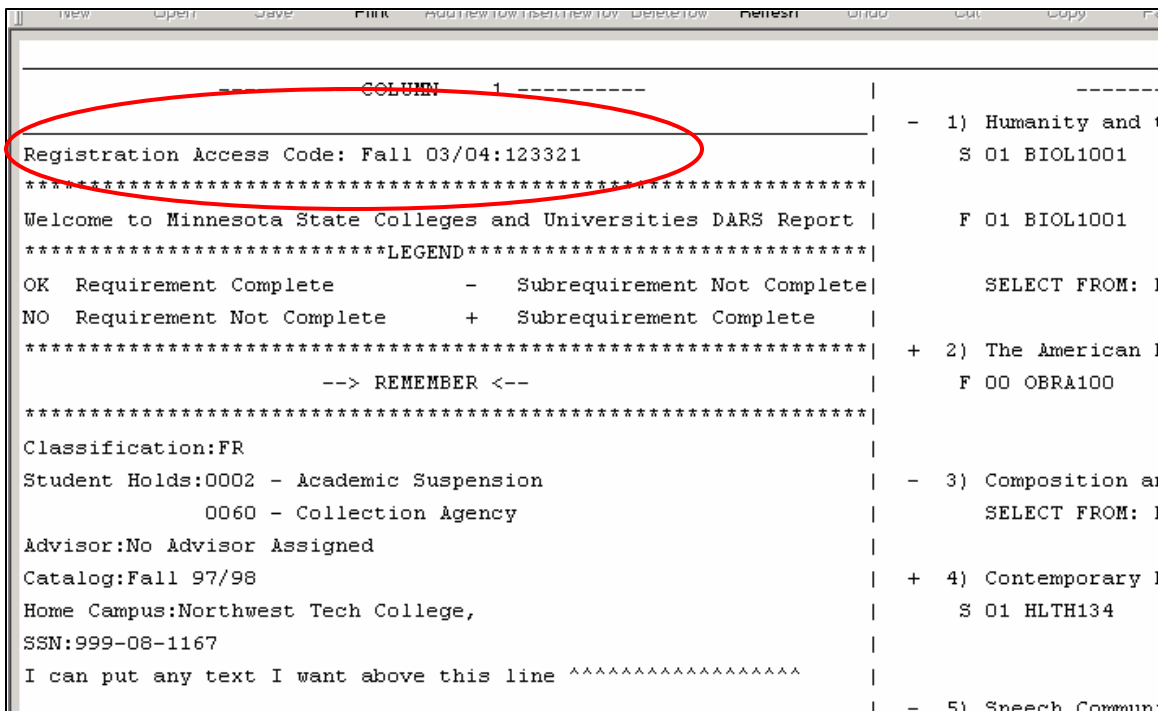
#RCRegistration Access Code: #

The entry has two basic components. One component is the actual command that is sent to DARwin. The second component is text.

Command: The opening #RC and the final # symbol represent the command portion of the entry and they tell DARwin what to get and display. This should be left justified.

Text: The text can be entered immediately following the #RC and can be any length up the number of spaces available between the first character of the text and the total number of spaces on that line minus the number of spaces required to display the Registration Access Code (this will vary depending on whether or not spaces are entered between #RC and the actual beginning of the text). "Registration Access Code" is only an example. Feel free to use text that is more appropriate for your campus.

THE AUDIT



As can be seen on the audit, both the YRTR and Access Code from ST1108UG are displayed. The YRTR is the Short Description from UT3056UG.
